- A Saul was humble, started well as God changed his heart
10:1, 9, 22-24
- B Disobedience, love of power- God withdrew His blessing
13:7-14; 15:1-21
- C Jealousy and power as king, now controlled Saul’s actions
18:8-16, 25 ; 19:1-6, 10; 23:14
- D Sin led Saul to kill 85 priests, consult witch, take his life
22:6-19; 22:14-15; 28:1-25; 31:2-4; Deuteronomy 18:9-14

II David, man after God’s own heart, was blessed by God

- A God chose David as youth, as his heart was right with God
13:14; 16:6-12; 23:4-14
- B God was with David, prepared him for future service- trials
17:34-37, 50; 16:18, 21-23; 18:5-7; 22:1-2; 23:13
- C David refused to kill Saul twice, although encouraged by others
24:4-20; 26:9-12
- D David made mistakes, told lies, so Saul kills priests 21:1-9
