- I 5:1-24 God repeats 10 Commandments after 38 years**
A 5:1-6, 22-24 God as leader made Covenant with Israel
B 5:7-15 Laws 1-4 - Man's upward responsibility to God
C 5:16 Commandment 5- Family responsibility to parents
Ephesians 6:2-4; Matthew 19:5; Luke 14:26
D 5:17-21 Laws 6-10 - Social responsibilities to others
Genesis 9:5-6; Matthew 5:22, 28, 44-, 5:37; Exodus 20
- II 6:1-25 Obedient love to the Lord, their God - see 5:7-8**
A **Love** God fully, **teach** children God's word – 6:4-9
5:7-21; Matthew 22:37; Leviticus 19:18; Ephesians 6:4
B Blessing comes from **obeying** Bible 6:1-3, 17-19, 24-25
John 14:23-24
C Don't **forget** or **test** God in the promised land, which
has been fully developed by others 6:10-12, 16, 20-23
D **Fear**, **serve** God only, **reject** false gods, or **face** God's
judgement – 6:13-15, 24
- III Lord Jesus' response to Deut. 5-6, invites us - do same**
1 Used these verses to summarise 2 greatest commands
6:5, 5:16-21 used in Matthew 22:37-40
2 Used 6:13, 16 (+8:3) to resist Satan's 3 temptations in
Matthew 4:1-11 (4:10; 4:7; 4:4)
3 He loved God, didn't forget/test God, served, obeyed
by dying on cross to reconcile to God, all who believe
4 David's one sin led to break 6 others - 1 Samuel 11-12
4 Great message of forgiveness offered - Psalms 51, 32
