Introduction

- 1 I was recently talking to a non-Christian friend about how amazing the human body is
- 2 What's amazing is so many think it just evolved from an animal, rather than made by a Creator
- 3 His reply was it was illogical to believe in a Supreme Being who created the world!!!
- 4 Human body has many amazing things about it, with its ability to recover from injury, DNA etc
- 5 Human body has many parts, some seem to be more important than others, but all play a role
- 6 When one part suffers eg hit finger with hammer the whole body feels it, or players pull muscle

I The Church is the Body of Christ

A 12:12 Worldwide Church is called the Body of Christ, with Jesus as its Head

- 1 Bible gives a very good example of how the human body is just like the worldwide church
- 2 Human body has many parts all working together to make us live effectively in the world
- 3 Have a head, eyes, ears, legs, arms, throats, blood vessels, muscles, heart, all in one body.
- 4 In the same way the church is described as one body with one head, who is Jesus Christ.
- 5 Col. 1:18 "And He (Jesus) is the head of the body, the church"
- 6 Church has many parts and amazingly has spread to most countries all around the world.
- 7 Math 16:18 Jesus "I will build my church & the gates of Hades will not overcome it"
- 8 But there are thousands of churches who do not trust the Bible 100% as being God's word
- 9 They do not preach that to belong to Jesus and his church, a person **must repent of sin & believe** in Jesus as their own personal Saviour & **receive** Lord Jesus into their hearts/lives

B 12:13 The Holy Spirit baptizes each new believer from every culture, into one Body

- 1 Bible teaches that God, the Holy Spirit opens a person's eyes to realise he is a sinner under God's judgement and the only way to escape is to repent of sin, believe in Jesus
- 2 12:13 Doesn't matter from where a person comes in the world, **Holy Spirit** <u>makes person</u> a member of the worldwide Body of Christ, comes to live in new believer's heart-change
- 3 Holy Spirit then helps every new believer to grow as a Chn, to live for, obey Jesus daily
- 4 J'n 3:5 "No-one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water & the Spirit"
- 5 Being baptized in water **does not make** a person a Chn **just outward sign** of what has happened in heart **after** a believer has repented, believed, been born again by Holy Spirit

C 12:14-24 The Body has many different parts but all are equally important

- 1 As verses say, each human body is 1, has many different parts, all of which are important
- 2 No one part like the eye, or hand or foot or head can claim to be superior to the other parts
- 3 Some body parts are on the outside, some on inside, which can't be seen yet still important
- 4 In same way the Body of Christ has many parts, each of us having a special part to play. **eg** Musicians use their hands, eyes, ears, voices, minds, some feet, to help us **worship** God
- 5 At our service today, many are gifted in different ways welcoming-music-reading-C4K
- 6 Some do ministry that everyone sees, but others type, print bulletins, clean church-not seen
- 7 12:20 But all play parts in one body working together, of equal importance in God's eyes
- 8 Psalm 139:14 tells us God created each one of us, so each is fearfully & wonderfully made

D 12:25 - 26 All members of the Body should care for one another in suffering & honour

- 1 25 We need one another, **must help** 1 another, work together to bring glory to Body, Head **eg** If someone is sick, facing an operation or medical treatment, we should pray for them
- 2 There should be no divisions or jealousy between them work together to obey the Head
- 3 By working together all parts bring glory to the Head, thus building up our local church
- 4 At church, do we only speak to our friends **or do we try to speak** to **visitors**, <u>those alone</u>? **eg** Do we try to encourage other Christians in their faith, by talking about spiritual things

- D 5 The more mature Christians should help the newer Christians to grow spiritually in faith
 - 6 12:26 The unity of the church is seen in both suffering and honour
 - a Suffering by one part of our body, means the whole body hurts eg Have back problem
 - b If Chn churches are persecuted in many countries overseas, we should pray for them
 - c After disasters occur in non-Chns countries & aid is sent, often Chns won't be given any
 - d To help Chns in the Body of Christ receive help donate to Chn groups who send to them
 - 7 When 1 section of Christ's body is blessed with new converts, rejoice with them-Baptists!!

II 12:27-30, 7, 11 God Chooses Leaders to build up the Body of Christ

- A 12:27, 7,11 Every believer plays a part in the **church**, using gift(s) given by the **Holy** Spirit
 - 1 27 Paul tells each Chn in the church at Corinth, they are members of the Body of Christ
 - 2 This is <u>a great gift</u> from God to belong to the Body of Christ, <u>but brings big responsibility</u>
 - 3 As with a human body, each member of the Body of Christ has a part to play in his church
 - 4 12:7 Great thing about being a Chn is-God equips every Chn with gift(s) to work in church
 - 5 But the gift is not to bring glory to the individual, but <u>is to help</u> the **whole church** to **grow**
 - 6 12:11 It is God, the Holy Spirit who decides which spiritual gift(s) each person will receive
 - 7 Holy Spirit knows who we are, what we can do, so gives us right gifts to work in church
 - 8 We can certainly pray to find out what gift(s) He has given us and eagerly ask for certain gifts (12:31), but He knows us best and will decide which gift we can handle and use.

B The 19 Spiritual Gifts listed in the N.T. Letters are not complete, just examples Won't spend great deal of time on this subject as it can be controversial – 4 things

- 1 These are **gifts given** by God to every believer **to help build** the Body of Christ for **free**, so there are no grounds for boasting or pride about the particular gift(s) each are given.
- 2 There are many other gifts which God has given to believers, not listed in the N.T. eg Children's ministry, music, youth work, special prayer gift, comedy, drama, language...
- 3 The **only gifts repeated** in Romans, 1 Cor., Ephesians, 1 Peter are preaching, teaching These 2 gifts are **central** to the Book of Acts thru'out **used to equip others** for ministry
- 4 For this reason Paul wrote that gifts used without love are nothing in 1 Corinthians 13
- C 12:28-30 God chooses & gifts leaders to build up the Body of Christ, which is his Church
 - 1 28 God chooses leaders in the church to achieve certain goals, so must fit in with His plans
 - 2 God places them there to do a job in particular place at particular time –knows their hearts
 - 3 eg In 2005 Bruce was chosen to come here, focus was to be young families, cross-cultural
 - 4 28 God knew Stanley family had necessary gifts of the Holy Spirit to be effective in this
- 5 Eph 4:7, 11-12 gives a good summary of how these leaders should exercise, use their gifts

"It was Christ who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, ... evangelists ... pastors & teachers to prepare God's people for works of service so Body of Christ may be built up

- 6 <u>Leaders are chosen to</u> a disciple & <u>build up</u> other church members b <u>Teach them</u> how to find their God-given gifts c encourage them to use their gifts d to make the church strong e To reach out into the community f <u>Make church grow</u> g <u>Learn Bible</u> at home groups etc.
- 7 Prophet a Can tell future like Isaiah b Preaches God's word, encourages, warns re sin
- 8 Teacher a Clearly explains God's word b Helps folk remember it cApplies it to their lives
- 9 Gifts of helps, administration handle finance, admin., help new members, church growth
- 10 12:29-30 We all can't have these very public gifts, but like body parts every gift is needed
- 11 **But a** Everyone has special place in the Body of Christ **b** You have place just right for you **c** Each of us must find that place **d** Bring glory to God by filling their place well in Body

III Important things for each to ask self? - Importance of allowing God to change us within

- 1 Have you been baptized into Christ's Body by Holy Spirit after repenting, believing in Jesus
- 2 Have you a Found out what your spiritual gift(s) is b Are you using these to help build Body
