I Background to Genesis 2 and 3

A Bible writers believed these events took place

Genesis 5:3; 1 Corinthians 15:21-22; 1 Timothy 2:13-14

B God’s greatest enemy was also present - Revelation 12:9; John 8:44

C Genesis 2:9, 15-17 Two trees named, God generous, 1 rule to obey

D God of the Bible is Creator, holy, truth, just, loving, all powerful...

1 Peter 1:18-21

II Genesis 3:1-13 Entry of sin and its results

A 3:1-5 Satan through serpent/snake makes Eve doubt God’s love

B 3:6 This one act of eating has enormous consequences for all since

C 3:7-13 Immediate results to this act of disobeying God-blame others

III Genesis 3:14-24 Consequences of this rebellion for them, all since

A 3:14-15 God’s judgement on snake -allowed Satan to enter, deceive

B 3:15 God’s judgement on Satan through 1special descendant of Eve

John 12:31; Revelation 20:10; Romans 16:20

C 3:16 God’s judgement (3 things) on Eve, all women born since then

D 3:17-19 God’s judgement on man, finally responsible-as home head

E 3:22-24 God denied access to (eternal) tree of life as he rebelled

Revelation 22:2-3, 14-15 **Tree of life** waiting in heaven for all who

repent, believe in, Jesus under the New Covenant

IV How this affects everyone born into world since then-except Jesus

1 Romans 5:12 Everyone is born self-centered, under God’s judgement

2 Are consequences in every person’s life, for rebelling against God

3 Sin is like a whirlpool in two special ways

4 Nothing anyone can do through own efforts to escape God’s

Judgement - Romans 3:23 “All have sinned and fall short

5 Romans 6:23 Basis of New Covenant - God offers everyone the gift

of eternal life to be with God in heaven, but must **accept it by faith**
